I like playing with my friends, Sol and William. I like apples, especially red ones.



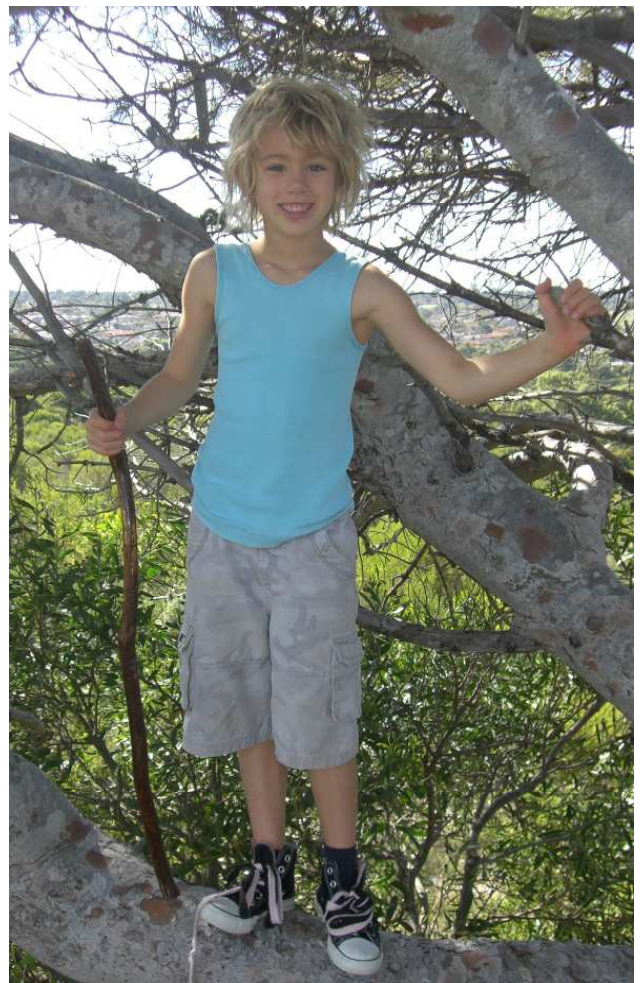
I went to the festival in my costume. My costume was a bird. We had to walk for a long time but it was still fun. We got to drive the bus to Fremantle and back to school.
